- Building personal relationships across the diocese by fostering and educating a network of formation leaders to support and advance diocesan formation initiatives.
- Collaborating with faith communities to develop meaningful strategies for discipleship and leadership formation.
- Developing a cohesive vision and strategy for diocesan formation programs that reflect a commitment to a life of following Jesus.
- Maintaining a current awareness of practices and events that build diocesan formation practices.
- Working closely with the Commission on Christian Formation to strengthen their mutual ownership of this work.
- Strengthening and supporting sub-committees to sustain diocesan formation efforts.
- Increasing congregational discipleship to 30% by 2027.
- Assuming primary responsibility for creating and managing online event registration for diocesan adult and youth retreats.
- Collaborating with diocesan clergy, congregations, ministries, and diocesan

- entities to promote events, initiatives, and participation.
- Providing formation training, resources, and support for congregations and institutions in the diocese.
- Managing the Christian Formation budget, resources, and volunteer staff.
